NSW Rural Fire Service partnering with CSI

During severe weather events flood-affected towns can become isolated.

Townships can be cut off by floodwaters, requiring the assistance of the SES and RFS.

Rescue work can be delayed, leaving communities stranded in their homes for several days.

RFS saw a need to provide vehicle-based flood rescue kits.

In comes CSI.

CSI packed 4,000 flood rescue kits.

The kits are a waterproof duffle bag packed with personal floating devices, helmets, rescue tools and instructions.

The work provided full time employment to inmates for close to six weeks.

The flood kits will not only help people in need, but contribute to the safety of first responders!
